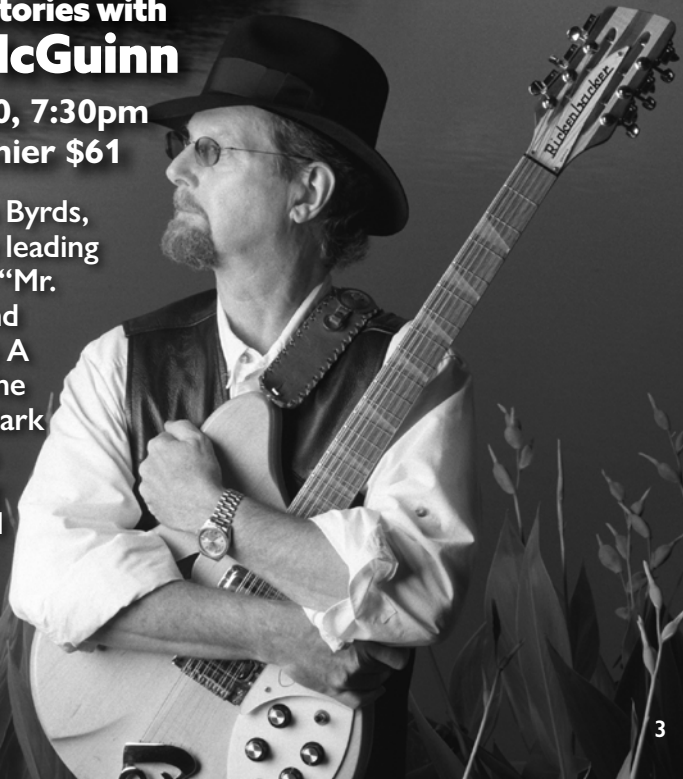


### Songs and Stories with **Roger McGuinn**

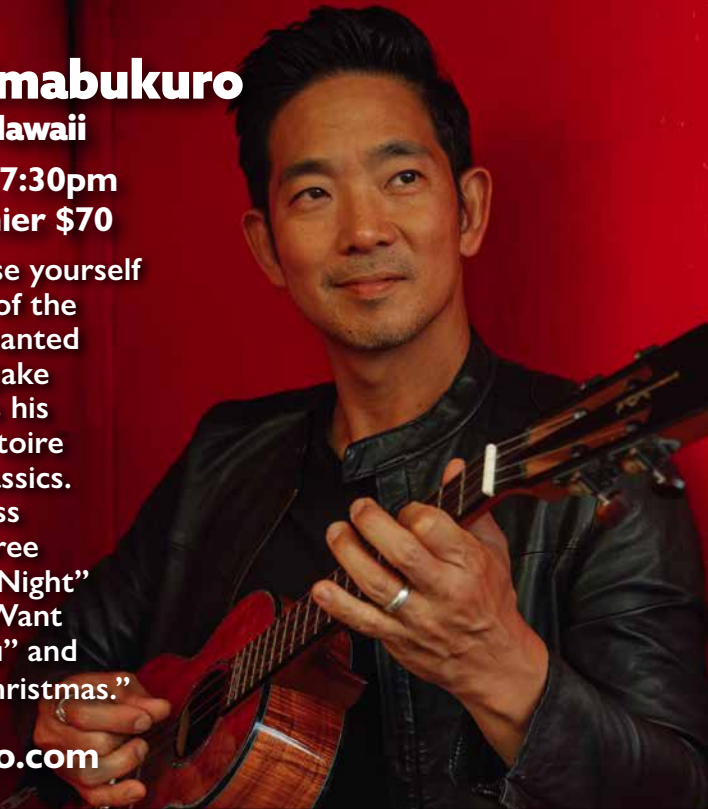

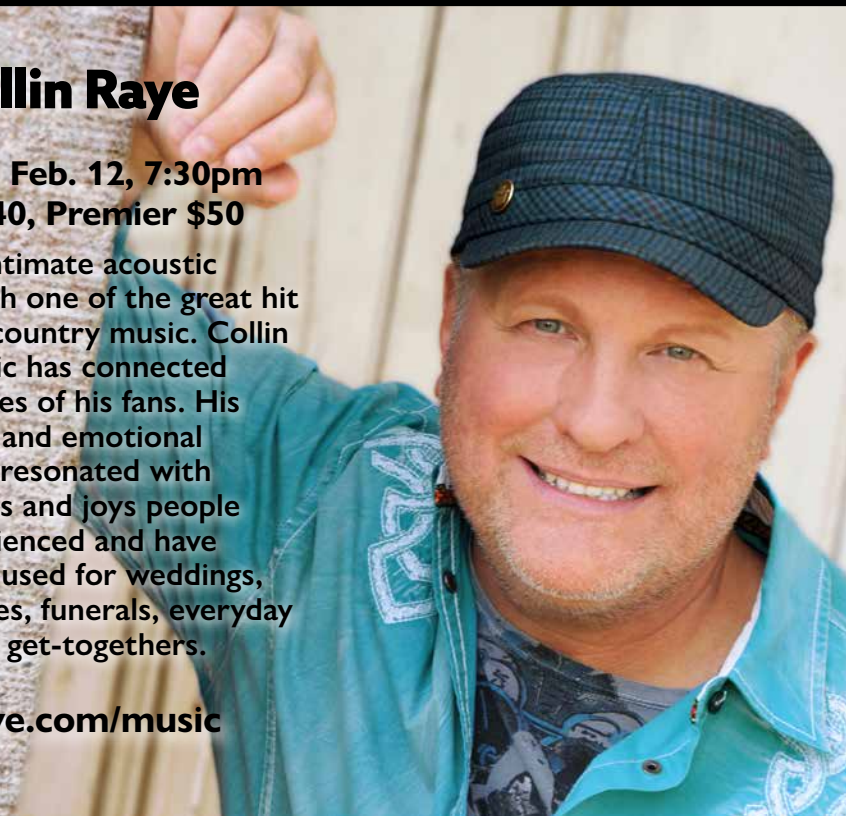

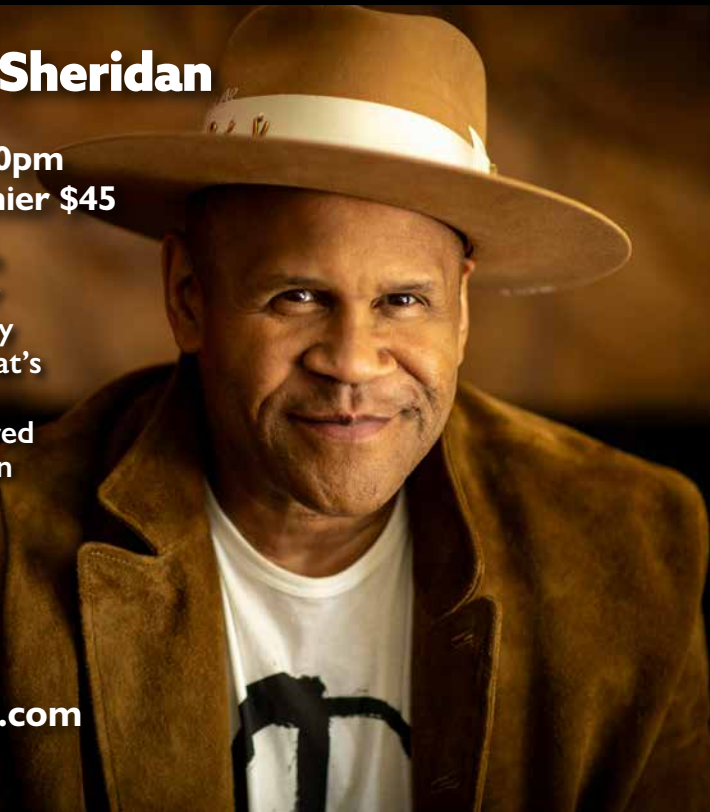
## Rondell Sheridan

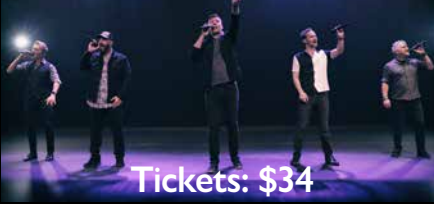

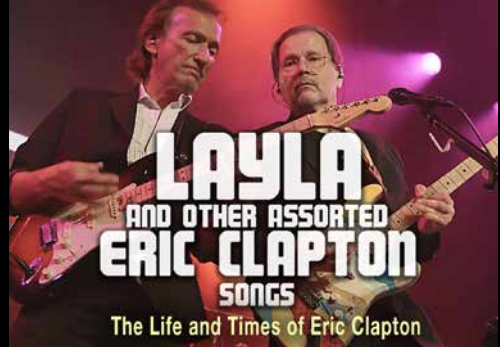
